That's Roman immortality of the soul dogma. The SDA church stated:

"We will never reach sinless perfection in this life..." R.S. Watts, GC Vice-President, Review and Herald, May 19, 1966, p 4.

"We should remember that <u>only</u> when Jesus comes can we be made perfect." *Ministry Magazine, December, 1965, p 9.*

Jesus said, "Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect." - Matthew 5:48

REJECTION OF RIGHTEOUSNESS BY FAITH MESSAGE In 1888, the SDA leaders <u>rejected</u> the message of the righteousness or justification by faith which is "the three angel's message in verity." Review and Herald, April 1, 1890.

"The true religion, the only religion of the Bible, that teaches forgiveness only through the merits of a crucified and risen Saviour, that advocates <u>righteousness by the faith of the Son of God</u>, has been <u>slighted</u>, <u>spoken against</u>, <u>ridiculed</u>, and <u>rejected</u>. It has been <u>denounced</u> as leading to enthusiasm and fanaticism." *Pamphlet 133. November 3, 1890.*

SDA leaders continue to reject the message as they did in 1888.

"In 1888 the direction of the Adventist Church took an upward turn at the Minneapolis ministerial pre-session... and the church has not been the same since. The 1985 World Ministers Council follows in the tradition of 1888." *Ministry magazine, November,* 1984, p 22.

ECUMENISM - FALSE UNITYThe goal of the World Council of Churches (WCC) is to unite all the religions of the world into a one world church under the

Vatican's guidance. Since the SDA leadership removed God as their head, they are now let to put dependence on human power. The SDA church has joined with the Pope's ecumenical movement.

"Over one hundred theologians met in Lima, Peru, in January 1982, and recommended unanimously to transmit this agreed statement—the Lima text—for the common study and official response of the churches. They represented virtually all the major church traditions: Eastern Orthodox, Oriental Orthodox, Roman Catholic, Old Catholic, Lutheran, Anglican, Reformed, Methodist, United, Disciples, Baptist, Adventist and Pentecostal.

"The churches' response to this agreed statement will be a vital step in the ecumenical process of 'reception'." Baptism, Eucharist and Ministry, Faith and Order Paper #111, back cover, published by the WCC, 1982.

Rome's "Eucharist" is a "heaven-insulting heresy" (4SOP 63) and is now found in the beliefs of the SDA church as confirmed in 1991 report:

"And we could go on if space permitted--to mention the WCC's... accentuation of the Holy Spirit and the Eucharist. All of these emphases fit into the ambit of the three angels' messages." Adventist Review, May 2, 1991, p 10.

The SDA church said long ago that "The capstone of the ecumenical effort came with the creation of the World Council of Churches... On the basis of Bible prophecy and the writings of Ellen G. White, SDA's anticipate the eventual success of the ecumenical movement both in eliminating the divisions of Protestantism and in reuniting Christendom by bridging the gulf that separates non-Catholic communions from Rome... SDA's envision this crusade as the great apostasy to which John the

revelator refers as `Babylon the great.' They understand, also, that God's last message of mercy to the world prior to the return of Christ in power and glory will consist of a warning against this great apostate movement, and a call to all who choose to remain loyal to Him to leave the churches connected with it." SDA Encyclopedia, vol 10, p 410-411.

There you have it! The SDA church just declared herself to be part of Babylon by her current beliefs. Better yet, they just told her members to separate themselves from her in order to remain loyal to God! The startling possibility "of becoming a sister to fallen Babylon" came to reality! (See Letter 51, September 6, 1886)

God is pleading for His honest obedient children to leave this apostate church and take their stand with the remnant.



when the people came out of the fallen Protestant churches who rejected the first and second angels' message of Revelation 14. Due to the SDA people's faith; God entrusted them with a message of warning to the world. But the SDA people also received a solemn warning through their prophet, Ellen G. White that a "great changes" inspired by Satan would lead to its apostasy and spiritual fall if they refused to walk on the platform of truth thereby rejecting God's warning; because as we know, God's promises are always conditional on OBEDIENCE.

SOLEMN WARNING

In 1903; God warned through Sister White that these "great changes" were going to take place within the SDA church due to Satan's plan to move the leaders in the church to give up the pillars of our faith.

"The enemy of souls has sought to bring in the supposition that a great reformation was to take place among Seventh-day Adventists, and that this reformation would consist in giving up the doctrines which stand as the pillars of our faith, and engaging in a process of reorganization. Were this reformation to take place, what would be the result?-- The principles of truth that God in His wisdom has given to the remnant church would be discarded. Our religion would be changed. The fundamental principles that have sustained the work for the last fifty years would be accounted as error. A new organization would be established. Books of a new order would be written. A system of intellectual philosophy would be introduced. The founders of this system would go into the cities and do a wonderful work. The Sabbath, of course, would be allowed

to stand in the way of the new movement. The leaders would teach that virtue is better than vice, but God being removed, they would place their dependence on human power, which, without God, is worthless. Their foundation would be built on the sand, and storm and tempest would sweep away the structure." - Letter 242, October 1903, Special Testimonies, Series B#7, p 39-40.

Just before Ellen White's death in July of 1915, God sent a final warning to the SDA church:

"I am charged to tell our people, that do not realize, that the devil has device after device, and he carries them out in ways that they do not expect. Satan's agencies will invent ways to make sinners out of saints. I tell you now, that when I am laid to rest, great changes will take place. I do not know when I shall be taken; and I desire to warn all against the devices of the devil. I want the people to know that I warned them fully before my death." - Manuscript #1. February 24, 1915.

GREAT CHANGES - SAD FULFILLMENT

Did the SDA church implement Satan's "great changes" that were designed to lead them to complete apostasy today? Can we see these "great changes" taking place after Sister White died? Let's let the SDA church leadership verify this fulfillment with their very own words. And as you read their statements, ask yourself, would the SDA pioneers join the church of today with all these "changed" fundamental beliefs?

"Most of the founders of Seventh-day Adventism would <u>not</u> be able to join the church <u>today</u> if they had to subscribe to the <u>denomination's Fundamental Beliefs</u>. More specifically, most would not be able to agree to **belief number 2**, which deals with the

doctrine of the Trinity. For Joseph Bates the Trinity was an unscriptural doctrine, for James White it was that "old Trinitarian absurdity," and for M. E. Cornell it was a fruit of the great apostasy, along with such false doctrines as Sundaykeeping and the immortality of the soul." - Ministry Magazine, October, 1993, p 10.

Notice that the doctrine of the Trinity is the central doctrine of the Roman Catholic church according to the Catholic Encyclopedia: "The Trinity is the term employed to signify the central doctrine of the Christian religion -- the truth that in the unity of the Godhead there are Three Persons, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, these Three Persons being truly distinct one from another. Thus, in the words of the Athanasian Creed: "the Father is God, the Son is God, and the Holy Spirit is God, and yet there are not three Gods but one God." - Newadvent.org

As every SDA can attest to, the trinity, which is the "fruit of the great apostasy" was in fact incorporated into the SDA church's new fundamental beliefs statement along with the false doctrine of Sunday keeping and immortality of the soul as you will soon see.

ADVENTIST - CATHOLIC

Notice that the past General Conference president Neal C. Wilson admitted in writing that:

"...there is another universal and truly catholic organization, the Seventh-day Adventist Church." Adventist Review, March 5, 1981, p.3. Since the SDA church is now a "catholic organization"; when the Conference Office was asked about Sunday services in SDA churches they responded, "Sunday worship - is not a big deal". "... there's <u>nothing wrong</u> with worshiping on Sunday too." *May* 2002 - *Adventist Review, p 14 - NAD Edition.*

"What Do Seventh-day Adventists Believe? Hear pastor/ evangelist Jere Webb present a fresh look at `The Truth.' Subjects include...`Christ centered reasons for Sunday worship'..." Pacific Union Recorder, June 4, 1990, p 27.

SUNDAY WORSHIP is <u>actually</u> a very BIG deal! As Sabbath keepers we know it's not a Christ centered "Sabbath" at all, for it is the prophesied "mark of authority" of the Vatican. Rome even declares in writing...

Sunday is our MARK of authority... the church is above the Bible, and this transference of Sabbath observance is proof of that fact." Catholic Record of London, Ontario Sept 1.1923.

The Bible states that "the soul that sins, it shall die" (Ezekiel 18:20). But the SDA church teaches that no one can overcome all sin and God will not destroy you but instead will make you perfect and take you to heaven, giving you eternal life anyway.
