Modern Christendom is in a sad state. As Ancient Israel was unprepared for Christ's first coming, so the majority of Christians today are not ready for Christ's second coming.

The Bible says, "when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is. And every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself, even as he is pure." (1John 3:2-3)

When Jesus comes for His own, those who stand alive on earth **must perfectly reflect His spotless character.** Those who have daily followed the instruction, "work out your own salvation with fear and trembling" (Philippians 2:12), and have perfected characters, will "in the twinkling of an eye", "be changed", "For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality." (1 Corinthians 15:51-53)

Many people are aware of the sad state of affairs in modern Christendom. Homosexuality and the trans movement are accepted by many Christians. Fornication is the norm of the culture of the world, and is rampant among Christians. Unbiblical marriages, divorces, and remarriages are common. The Scriptures say, "Now when this was noised abroad, the multitude came together, and were confounded, because that **every man heard them**

speaking in his own language." (Acts 2:6) The disciples were speaking the languages of the various nations around them, even though they had never learned them. But this is not what was seen at Asbury. Even though it was claimed that people from all over the world were visiting this event, the supposed speakers of tongues at this event were speaking unintelligible gibberish. If this were a manifestation of the Holy Spirit, this would not be happening. As the Apostle Paul said, "Yet in the church I had rather speak five words with my understanding, that by my voice I might teach others also, than ten thousand words in an unknown tongue." (1 Corinthians 14:19) Here is one of the many evidences that this movement was not inspired by the Holy Spirit.

Was God's Law exalted at Asbury? There can be no genuine repentance from sin, where there is no conviction of sin. The Bible says that, "sin is the transgression of the law." (1 John 3:4) Were the eyes of the people opened to behold their transgression of God's Law? Were they taught the necessity of obedience to this Law? Was the error corrected, wherein many people falsely assume that God's Sabbath Day is Sunday, one of Christendom's most contentious points to date? Far too often, revivals like these excite people's emotions, and pander to their desire for something new and startling, rather than speaking the plain, unpopular, deep cutting truths that people need to hear to reform their lives.

We want the Holy Spirit to come down upon God's people. We want to see the manifestation of the Holy Spirit in a measure that is far greater than what the Apostles had seen. But if this is to happen, then as God's people we must become serious about our walks, more than we have ever been before. We must get back to Biblical Christianity, even if it costs us our friends, family members, loved ones, livelihoods, and even our lives.
